Zoe also placed second overall for the Step 2 overs after earning second place on the vault, beam and floor, and a third place on the bar.

Also competing in the Step 2s overs division were Chloe Sparrow, Brianna Knowles, Sophie Spod, Olivia Allison, Addie Tetze and Ashlee Jennings, with most of the athletes getting their first pass marks (a total score of over 50).

Whakatane also had six Step 1s competing for

Oshanna placed second on vault, and beam and was fifth overall in the overs division. The team of Marino, Chloe Hogg and Miley placed third overall.
