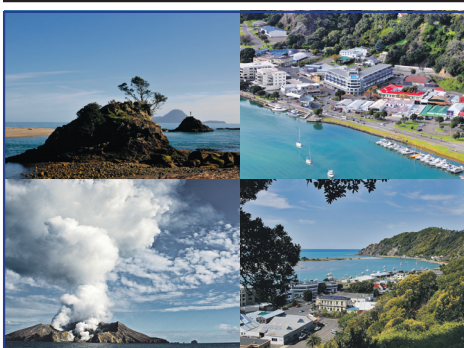

Personal bests at gym comp

EBOP Gymnastics athletes earned some good personal bests at the recent Hamilton city Gymsports junior competition.

Pass marks for women's artistic gymnastics (Wag) is 50 out of 60 possible points or an average of 12.5 on each apparatus (scored out of 15) at least two competitions.
